Chemistry of the Blood is the first of nine chapters. Heavy reading but worth the effort to read slowly. DeHaan was a medical doctor. This book and *Broken Things* are his most popular books. Each contain several radio broadcasts.

(Mark 13:19)

For we know that the whole **creation** groaneth and travaileth — in pain together until now.
(Romans 8:22)

The Packet is made up of eight subjects and each subject contains sixteen cards. At the top of each card, the subject appears in the middle and is followed by the number: 16. The number is a reminder of how many verses are in the subject. *The Packet* contains a total of 128 cards. But some of the cards contain more than one verse.

Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers,— walking after their own lusts, —And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? —for since the fathers fell asleep, —all things continue as they were from the beginning of the **creation**.

For this they willingly are ignorant of, —that **by the word of God** the heavens were of old, —and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:
(2Peter 3:3-5) (Read chapter 3)

But from the beginning of the **creation** —God made them male and female.

For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, — and cleave to his wife;
(Mark 10:6-7)

For the invisible things of him — from the **creation** of the world are clearly seen,—being understood by the things that are made, — even his eternal power and Godhead; —so that they are without excuse:
(Romans 1:20)

For by him were all things created — that are in heaven, — and that are in earth, — visible and invisible, —whether they be thrones, or dominions, — or principalities, or powers: — all things were **created** by him, and for him:
(Colossians 1:16)

Thou art worthy, O Lord, —to receive glory and honour and power: — for thou hast created all things, — and for thy pleasure they are and were **created**.
(Revelation 4:11)
