I sought the LORD, and he heard me, — and delivered me from all my fears. — This poor man cried, and **the LORD heard him.** — and saved him out of all his troubles. **(Psalms 34:4,6)**

Psalms 34:18

The LORD is nigh unto them — **that are of a broken heart;** — and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit. **(Psalms 34:18)**

Psalms 66:18

Card 3

If I regard iniquity in my heart, — **the Lord will not hear me:** **(Psalms 66:18)**

Psalms 139:23-24

Search me, O God, — and know my heart:— try me, and know my thoughts: — And see if there be **any wicked way in me,**— and lead me in the way everlasting. **(Psalms 139:23-24)**

Isaiah 59:1,2

Card 4

Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save;— neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: — But **your iniquities have separated between you and your God,** — and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. **(Isaiah 59:1,2)**

Jeremiah 33:3

Prayer 16

Card 5

Call unto me, and I will answer thee, — and shew thee great and mighty things, — which thou knowest not. **(Jeremiah 33:3)**

Psalms 5:2-3

Hearken unto the voice of my cry, my King, and my God: for unto thee will I pray. **My voice shalt thou hear in the morning,** O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up. **(Psalms 5:2-3)**

Matthew 7:7,8

Card 6

Ask, and it shall be given you; — seek, and ye shall find; — knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

For every one that asketh receiveth; — and he that seeketh findeth; — and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. **(Matthew 7:7,8)**

The verb tense means: "keep on asking, seeking, knocking."

Matthew 26:41

Card 7

Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: — the spirit indeed is willing, — but the flesh is weak. **(Matthew 26:41)**

Matthew 14:23

And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and **when the evening was come,** he was there alone. **(Matthew 14:23)**

Mark 1:35

Prayer 16

Card 8

And in the morning, rising up **a great while before day,** — he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed. **(Mark 1:35)**

Luke 6:12

And it came to pass in those days, that he went out into a mountain to pray, and continued **all night in prayer to God.** **(Luke 6:12)**
