And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the <u>shepherds said one to another</u>, Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us. (Luke 2:15)

And he said unto them, Where is your faith? And they being afraid wondered, <u>saying one to another</u>. What manner of man is this! for he commandeth even the winds and water, and they obey him. (Luke 8:25)

And he said unto them, What manner of <u>communications are these that ye have one to another</u>, as ye walk, and are sad? **(Luke 24:17)**

And they <u>said one to another</u>, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures? (Luke 24:32)

How can ye believe, which <u>receive honour one of another</u>, and seek not the honour that cometh from God only? **(John 5:44)**

If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to <u>wash one another's feet.</u> **(John 13:14)**

A new commandment I give unto you, That ye <u>love one another</u>; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have <u>love one to another</u>. **(John 13:34-35)**

So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one <u>members one of another</u>. (Romans 12:5)

Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; (Romans 12:10)

And be ye kind <u>one to another</u>, tenderhearted, <u>forgiving one another</u>, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you. (Ephesians 4:32)

For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: (17) Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore *comfort one another* with these words. (**1Thessalonians 4:16-18**)

Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. (13) But *exhort one another daily*, while it is called Today; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. (**Hebrews 3:12-13**)

<u>Confess your faults one to another</u>, and <u>pray one for another</u>, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much. (James 5:16)

Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.(IThessalonians 5:11)

Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but *exhorting one another*: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. **(Hebrews 10:25)**

One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts. (Psalm 145:4)

Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he <u>hath not another to help him up</u>. (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10)
