The Packet - The Blood8 - 16+

Moreover ye shall eat no manner of blood, whether it be of fowl or of beast, in any of your dwellings. Whatsoever soul it be that eateth any manner of blood, even that soul shall be cut off from his people. (Leviticus 7:26-27)

For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul. (Leviticus 17:11)

For if the blood of bulls and of goats, - and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, -sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall <u>the blood of Christ.</u> - who <u>through the eternal Spirit</u>—offered himself without spot to God, - purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? (Hebrews 9:13-14)

And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, - Now is come salvation, and strength, - and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: - for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, - which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb. - and by the word of their testimony; - and they loved not their lives unto the death. (Revelation 12:10-11)

But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, - we have fellowship one with another, - and <u>the blood of Jesus Christ his Son</u> cleanseth us from all sin. (1John 1:7)

If we confess our sins, - he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, - and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1John 1:9)

God that made the world and all things therein, - seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, - dwelleth not in temples made with hands; - Neither is worshipped with men's hands, - as though he needed any thing,- seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things; And hath <u>made of one blood all nations of men</u> for to dwell on all the face of the earth, - and hath determined the times before appointed, - and the bounds of their habitation; **(Acts 17:24-26)**

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, - from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the <u>precious blood of Christ</u>, - as of <u>a lamb</u> without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained <u>before the foundation of the world</u>, - but was manifest in these last times for you, (1Peter 1:18-20)

Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One <u>to see corruption</u>. (Acts 2:27) (To experience decay of the blood and flesh—to require burial in a grave.) • For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, - fell on sleep, and was laid unto his fathers, - and <u>saw corruption:</u> - But he, whom God raised again, - <u>saw no</u> <u>corruption.</u> (Acts 13:36-37)

It was therefore necessary that <u>the patterns of things in the heavens</u> should be purified with these; - but the heavenly things themselves with <u>better sacrifices than these</u>. - For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, - which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, - now to appear in the presence of God for us: Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place <u>every year with blood of others</u>; For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself. (**Hebrews 9:23-26**)

But this man, after he had offered <u>one sacrifice for sins</u> for ever, - sat down on the right hand of God; - For <u>by one offering</u> he hath perfected for ever - them that are sanctified. **(Hebrews 10:12,14)**

For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: - for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things - which are written in the book of the law to do them. (Galatians 3:10)

And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, - and the first begotten of the dead, - the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and *washed us from our sins in his own blood*. (Revelation 1:5)

Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, - repented himself, - and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, Saying, - I have sinned in that I have <u>betrayed the innocent blood.</u> - And they said, - What is that to us? - see thou to that. And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, - and went and hanged himself. (Matthew 27:3-5)

In whom we have redemption <u>through his blood</u>, - the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; (Ephesians 1:7) *Acts 15:24*Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, - subverting your souls, saying, - Ye must be circumcised, and keep the law:- to whom we gave no such commandment: (Acts 15:24)

For it seemed good to the Holy Ghost, and to us, - to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things; That ye <u>abstain from meats offered to idols</u>,- and <u>from blood</u>, - and from <u>things strangled</u>, - and <u>from fornication</u>: - from which if ye keep yourselves, - ye shall do well. (Acts 15:28-29)
